## MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: New License Plates: Barber Motor Sports Hall of Fame Motorcycle License Plate  
Redesigned Disabled Veteran License Plate

Two bills affecting motor vehicle registration passed during the 2007 Regular Session of the Alabama Legislature and were enacted into law. The act numbers, summary of the acts, and effective dates are provided below.

**Act 2007-379**, effective January 1, 2008, provides for a **distinctive motorcycle license plate for the Barber Vintage Motorsports Museum**. The annual additional fee is fifty dollars (\$50), and the license plate can be personalized. The annual additional fee for the motorcycle plates shall be distributed in accordance with the provisions of Section 32-6-68 of the Code of Alabama 1975. The Barber Vintage Motorsports Museum portion of the fee shall be used to defray the operating costs of the museum, a 501(c)3 non-profit foundation. This is the same distribution used for the Barber Vintage Motorsports Museum passenger plates. There is no pre-commitment period associated with the distinctive motorcycle license plate category.

The distinctive motorcycle license plate shall only be printed and issued as long as the Barber Vintage Motorsports Museum qualifies for a distinctive license plate category, pursuant to Section 32-6-64 of the Code of Alabama 1975, for passenger cars, pickup trucks, and self-propelled campers or house cars.

The primary tag type is not available at this time. This information will be provided at a later date.

**Act 2007-383**, effective January 1, 2008, provides for a redesign of the **distinctive passenger license plate for disabled veterans designating the branch of service in which the veteran served**. The license plate will be designed by the Department of Revenue and will contain a place for a decal to be placed which indicates the branch of service that the veteran served.

The primary tag type will remain DV.
