SUBJECT: Helping Uninsured Children License Plate Category

The State Comptroller's Office has provided the Department of Revenue with the Commitment-to-Purchase figures for the period ending August 31, 2007. A copy of the report has been attached for your convenience. The "Helping Uninsured Children" license plate category has exceeded the minimum required 1,000 pre-commitments for Quantity Class 2. **Effective immediately**, please discontinue accepting commitment-to-purchase applications for this license plate category. The Motor Vehicle Division has contacted the sponsoring organization, and the license plate design approval process is in progress. As soon as an expected delivery date has been established, we will notify each county.

The tag types assigned to this license plate category are "**HL**" for **pre-numbered** and "**HX**" for **personalized plates**. These plates have a maximum of **six (6) alphanumeric characters**. The new tag scheme is as follows: **10CA0-99CZ9**, with a spin cycle of "32541". The Motor Vehicle Division will notify each county when personalized requests may be accepted.
