## State Extends Time for Mobile County Property Owners to File Appeals

Montgomery—The Alabama Department of Revenue (ADOR) announced today that Mobile County property owners will have additional time to file written protests to the Mobile County Board of Equalization, appealing their 2012 property valuations, due to the severe weather conditions caused by Hurricane Isaac.

In an order issued Sept. 6, 2012, State Revenue Commissioner Julie P. Magee extended the deadline from Aug. 30, 2012, to Sept. 14, 2012, to allow Mobile County property owners additional time to file any appeals which otherwise they would have been unable to do as a result of severe weather conditions caused by Hurricane Isaac.
