Sign up Now for Free Business Privilege and Corporate Shares Tax Seminars

MONTGOMERY, July 6, 2000—The Alabama Department of Revenue, the Alabama Chapter of the National Association of Tax Practitioners, and area chambers of commerce will host a free one-day seminar on the state's new business privilege and corporate shares tax law in six key area locations, beginning in mid-July through early August. The seminars begin at 9 a.m. and conclude at 4:30 p.m. Pre-registration is required due to limited seating.

Participants attending the seminars are eligible to receive up to eight hours of CPE credit as approved by the Alabama State Board of Public Accountancy and six hours of CLE credit as approved by the Alabama State Bar Association.
