REVENUE COMMISSIONER DWIGHT CARLISLE RESIGNS TO SERVE ON AUBURN UNIVERSITY BOARD OF TRUSTEES

MONTGOMERY - Gov. Bob Riley today accepted the resignation of Alabama Department of Revenue Commissioner Dwight Carlisle. Carlisle resigned today after being confirmed by the Alabama Senate to serve on the Auburn University Board of Trustees.

"Dwight has been a valuable member of my Cabinet and has done a tremendous job of moving the Department of Revenue in the right direction," Riley said. "I am thankful for his unselfish service and know he will be a great leader for Auburn University."

Assistant Commissioner Cynthia Underwood will serve as Interim Commissioner of Revenue until a replacement for Carlisle is appointed.

Along with Carlisle, the Alabama Senate also confirmed Gadsden city planner Charles Ball and Fayette elementary school principal Sarah Newton to the Auburn Board of Trustees.
