Subject: OneSpot - Notice of Payment Processing Change

Effective March 3, 2014, the ONE SPOT Debit Payment process has changed, having only two debits from your bank account per local tax return filed: one debit for all state administered and one debit for **all** non-state administered local tax payments.

Previously, each non-state administered (NSA) local tax payment was a separate debit from your bank account. The NSA will still receive your payment separately, as they have in the past. Should you ever need to provide proof of payment, the local tax return that was filed with payment has a Payment Summary page that will show the breakdown of the lump sum debit payment that corresponds to your bank's debit record.
