## Alabama Corporate E-file Restriction Removed

Montgomery, March 1, 2012—The Alabama Department of Revenue (ADOR) announced today that Alabama business taxpayers can now file their state corporate income tax returns and tax schedules electronically.

Last year, the ADOR was forced to restrict the electronic filing of certain corporate income tax returns due to processing errors associated with federal consolidated filers. Corrective action has since been taken and testing completed to allow for the electronic filing of all corporate returns and schedules for this filing season. Calendar-year 2011 corporate returns are due March 15, 2012.

The ADOR advises that for these consolidated filers the 2012 filing season will be considered a transitional year. These taxpayers will have the option to electronically-file or paper-file their 2011 tax year corporate returns.
