ADOR Extends April 17 Filing to Include Oil and Gas Severance Taxpayers

Montgomery—The Alabama Department of Revenue (ADOR) announced today that Alabama taxpayers who file oil and gas severance tax returns will have until Tuesday, April 17, 2007, to file their February 2007 Alabama returns, normally due April 15, and pay any tax due.

State Revenue Commissioner Tom Surtees authorized the extra filing and payment time for oil and gas severance taxpayers to coincide with the recently announced April 17, 2007, state and federal tax-filing and payment deadline date.

The April 17, 2007, deadline will apply to the following:

- 2006 Alabama individual income tax returns, whether filed electronically or on paper.
- Requests for an automatic six-month tax-filing extension, whether submitted electronically or on a paper Form 4868A.
- Individual estimated tax returns and payments for the first quarter of 2007 (Form 40ES).
- Any other Alabama income, financial institution excise, business
 privilege tax returns, or oil and gas severance tax returns administered
 by the ADOR, having an April 15, 2007, filing and payment deadline
 date.
