## Mingledorff Named Alabama Commissioner of Revenue

*Montgomery, Ala., Dec. 15, 1999*—Gov. Don Siegelman appointed George E. Mingledorff III to the post of acting state revenue commissioner, effective Dec. 15, 1999.

Mr. Mingledorff, a career department employee and assistant revenue commissioner, assumed the duties of revenue commissioner following James Hayes' assignment as senior policy advisor to Gov. Don Siegelman, also effective Dec. 15.

Mingledorff's Dec. 15 appointment marks the third time he has been named to the post of revenue commissioner by Alabama governors.

Mingledorff, 51, began his career with the Alabama Department of Revenue in 1975 as a revenue field examiner. In November 1983, he was appointed assistant chief of the Income Tax Division, and shortly thereafter, named chief. In April 1989, Mr. Mingledorff was appointed assistant commissioner of the Revenue Department, the senior merit position within the department.

Mingledorff is a member of the Southeastern Association of Tax Administrators, the Federation of Tax Administrators, the National Tax Association-Tax Institute of America, the Association of Government Accountants, and is Alabama's designated representative on the Multistate Tax Commission.

A native of Montgomery, Ala., Mingledorff graduated from the University of Alabama and Auburn University in Montgomery with degrees in mathematics and accounting, respectively. He later earned an M.B.A. from Auburn University in Montgomery.

He and his wife Sarah have two adult children and one grandchild.
