## 2014 Legislative Acts

On April 10, 2014 Governor Robert Bentley signed into law Act 2014-430. This Act becomes effective on October 1, 2014 and requires all applicants for a new or renewal business privilege license to provide to the issuing agent the applicant's federal employer identification number (FEIN) or social security number (SSN) if an individual. This information must be included with the license information reported to the Department by each county each month. In addition, this Act requires that all business privilege license information be transmitted **electronically**, i.e., via email, diskette or CD, to the Department by the probate judge or county licensing official. Enclosed is the data specification sheet to be used when submitting this information in the required .txt file format.

On March 13, 2014 Governor Robert Bentley signed into law Act 2014-157, known as the Facilitating Business Rapid Response to Declared Disaster Act of 2014. This Act became effective immediately. Per this Act, out-of-state businesses performing disaster or emergency related work on infrastructure owned or operated by a registered business, municipality, county, or public corporation shall not be considered to have established residency and are not subject to any state or local taxes, <u>licensing</u>, registration, or filing requirement including, without limitation, state or local income taxes, payroll taxes, <u>occupational and business licensing fees</u>, etc. (Emphasis added.) Therefore, these companies are exempt from the business privilege licenses related to a disaster or an emergency declared by Alabama's Governor or the President of the United States.
