ALDOR to Consider Relief for Taxpayers Affected by Hurricane Sally

MONTGOMERY, Sept. 15, 2020 – In accordance with the state of emergency declared by Gov. Kay Ivey, the Alabama Department of Revenue (ALDOR) will consider, on a case-by-case basis, relief from late filing penalties for Alabama taxpayers who in the coming days and weeks are unable to timely file tax returns as a result of damage or disruptions caused by Hurricane Sally.
