TO: ALL PERSONS, FIRMS, AND CORPORATIONS engaged in the business of leasing or renting tangible personal property in the **City of Jacksonville** Alabama, and its police jurisdiction (located in Calhoun County)

On October 9, 2017, the governing body of the City of Jacksonville adopted Ordinance No. 0-602-18 changing the rates of the City of Jacksonville rental tax <u>effective December 1, 2017</u>. The new rental tax rates are shown below:

Rental Tax Rates:	Old Rates	New Rates
Lease or rental of tangible personal property	2%	3%
Lease or rental of automotive vehicles, truck trailers,		
semi-trailers and house trailers	.50%	1%
Lease or rental of linens and garments	2%	3%

If rentals/leases are made to lessees outside the corporate limits of the City of Jacksonville but within the police jurisdiction, the rates of tax are one-half of those stated above.

The Law requires that City of Jacksonville rental tax be collected, reported and remitted in the same manner as the State rental tax. The City of Jacksonville rental tax is to be included on the electronic local tax return assigned to you (City and County Tax Return, form 9501). Enter the gross amounts and deductions, and all calculations will be done automatically for you. These taxes are filed online through My Alabama Taxes (MAT) at myalabamataxes.alabama.gov.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 20-81 OF CHAPTER 20 – TAXATION ARTICLE IV. RENTAL/LEASING TAX OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, ALABAMA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE:

SECTION I. Section 20-81 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Jacksonville is hereby amended, to read as follows:

Sec. 20-81. - Levy and amount of tax.

- (a) In addition to all other taxes now imposed by law, there is hereby levied and shall be collected as herein provided a privilege or license tax on each person engaging or continuing within the city or the police jurisdiction thereof in the business of leasing or renting tangible personal property at the rate of three percent (3.0%) of the gross proceeds derived by the lessor from the lease or rental of tangible personal property; provided, that the said privilege or license tax on each person engaging or continuing within this state in the business of leasing or renting any automotive vehicle or truck trailer, semitrailer or house trailer shall be at the rate of one percent (1.0%) of the gross proceeds derived by the lessor from the lease or rental of such automotive vehicle or truck trailer, semitrailer or house trailer; provided further, that the tax levied in this article shall not apply to any leasing or rental, as lessor, by the state, or any municipality or county in the state, or any public corporation organized under the laws of the state, including without limiting the generality of the foregoing, any corporation organized under the provisions of Code of Ala. 1975, §§ 11-54-80—11-54-101, provided further, that the privilege or license tax on each person engaging or continuing within this state in the business of the leasing and rental of linens and garments shall be at the rate of three (3.0%) percent of the gross proceeds derived by the lessor from the lease or rental of such linens and garments.
- (b) The privilege license levied by subsection (a) of this section shall apply to every person conducting said business of renting or leasing tangible personal property outside the corporate limits of the city, but within the police jurisdiction thereof, at one-half the rate prescribed by subsection (a) of this section.

SECTION II. The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, then such ruling shall not affect any other paragraphs and sections, since the same would have been enacted by the municipal council without the incorporation of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

SECTION III. Effective upon adoption of this ordinance to the extent that all other ordinances or parts of ordinances of the City of Jacksonville conflicting herewith or inconsistent with the provisions in this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION IV - Effective date.
