AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 11 OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES, TAXES AND REGULATIONS, ARTICLE VI. ROOM RENTAL PRIVILEGE TAX, SEC. 11-109.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Ozark, Alabama, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 11 Article VI, Sec. 11-109 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Ozark, Alabama is hereby amended so that Sec. 11-109 thereof shall read in its entirety as follows:

"Sec. 11-109, Levy in city. There is hereby levied and imposed, in addition to all other taxes now imposed by law, a privilege or license tax upon every person engaging in the business of renting or furnishing any rooms, lodgings or accommodations to transients in any hotel, motel, inn or any other place in which rooms, lodgings or other accommodations are regularly furnished to transients for a consideration, in an amount to be determined by the application of the rate of five (5) percent of the charge of such rooms, lodgings or other accommodations, including the charge for use or rental of personal property and services furnished in such room provided, however, there is exempted from the tax any rental or services taxed under the provisions of the city sales tax ordinance. The tax shall not apply to rooms, lodgings or accommodations supplied for a period of thirty (30) continuous days or more."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective October 1, 2019 after its adoption and publication as required by law.

There is hereby levied and imposed, in addition to all other taxes now imposed by law, a privilege or license tax upon every person engaging in the business of renting or furnishing any rooms, lodgings or accommodations to transients in any hotel, motel, inn or any other place in which rooms, lodgings or other accommo-dations are regularly furnished to transients for a consideration, in an amount to be de-termined by the application of the rate of five (5) percent of the charge of such rooms, lodgings or other accommodations, including the charge for use or rental of personal property and services furnished in such room provided, however, there is exempted from the tax any rental or services taxed under the provisions of the city sales tax ordinance. The tax shall not apply to rooms, lodgings or accommodations supplied for a period of thirty (20) continuous doubles taxed. (30) continuous days or more. Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective October 1, 2019 after its adoption and publication as required by law.
