Please find enclosed Ordinance #0-002-2020 which amended Ordinance 0-001-2020 that was previously sent to your agency from the City of Southside. THIS ORDINANCE AS PRESENTED WILL AMEND ORDINANCE 0-001-2020 BY ADDING "SECTION 6" TO
ORDINANCE 0-001-2020 DECLARING THE PROPERTY ANNEXED
WILL ALSO BE EXTENDING THE POLICE JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF SOUTHSIDE, ALABAMA

WHEREAS, on January 13th, 2020 the Southside City Council did adopt Ordinance #0-001-2020 annexing into the city limits of the city of Southside, Alabama 93.82 acres of property located in Calhoun County. Said Ordinance 0-001-2020 was recorded at the Calhoun County Probate Office of Alice K. Martin on January 24, 2020 in book 3259 page 569 and;



AN ORDINANCE ASSENTING TO THE ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY OWNED BY BIG OAK RANCH, INC.
