The following was presented and adopted by vote of the Leighton, Alabama, Town Council on the Ith day of January, 2022.

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 1993-A SECTION 1(a), AS AMENDED, OF THE TOWN OF LEIGHTON TO PROVIDE FOR .5% INCREASE IN GENERAL SALES TAX

Be it ordained by the Town Council of Leighton, Alabama, Colbert County:

Section 1(a) of Ordinance No. 1993-A of the Town of Leighton, as amended, which was adopted by the Town Council and approved by the Mayor of Leighton on July 19, 1993, and which was amended by ordinance adopted by the Town Council and approved by the Mayor of said Town on April 4, 1994, is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

(a) Upon every person, firm, or corporation (including the State of Alabama, the University of Alabama, Auburn University, and all other institutions of higher learning in the state, whether such institutions by denominational, state, county, or municipal institution, and any association or other agency or instrumentality of such institutions) engaged or continuing within the Town in the business of selling at retail any tangible personal property whatsoever, including merchandise and commodities of every kind and character, (not including, however, bonds or other evidences of debts or stocks, nor sale or sales of material and supplies to any person for use in fulfilling a contract for the painting, repair, or reconditioning of vessels, barges, ships and other watercraft of over fifty tons burden), an amount equal to three and one half percent (3.5%) of the gross proceeds of sales of the business, except where a different amount is expressly provided herein. Provided, however, that any person engaging or continuing in business as a retailer and wholesaler or jobber shall pay the tax required on the gross proceeds of retail sales of such business at the rates specified, when his books are kept so as to show separately the gross proceeds of sales of each

business, and when his books are not so kept he shall pay the tax as a retailer on the gross sales of the business.
