Acts 2018-261 & 2018-474

- Allows parent or legal guardian of disabled minor to obtain disability plates or placards
- Effective – June 1, 2018
- Authorizes registered nurse practitioner and nurse midwife to certify disability parking privileges
- Effective – March 28, 2018
- Application For Disability Access Parking Privileges form (MVR 32-6-230) updated (Memo 2018- 004)



Act 2018-190 (SB214)

- Vehicle owner opts-in/out to disclose certain personal info to sponsoring organization at the time of initial registration
 - Owner name
 - Owner address
 - Owner email address, if available
- DOR provides info to sponsoring organization annually, upon request
- Sponsoring organization prohibited from reselling info
- Includes: distinctive, collegiate and plates approved by LOC
- Opt-in/out disclosure included in registration record, PROS and Pre-commitment
- Opt-in/out language added to POD registration receipt affidavit
- Effective: January 1, 2019

House Joint Resolution 14

- Research and draft recommendations to combat curbstoning and abandoned vehicle fraud
- Recommendations submitted to legislature by February 2019
- Proposed legislative changes:
 - Master dealer regulatory license
 - Increase dealer license fee
 - Vehicle auction license
 - Require abandoned vehicles to be bonded
 - Increase title hold time on abandoned vehicles
 - Expand enforcement provisions



Fleet Registration Portal

Proposed legislation:

- DOR portal to allow registration and renewal of fleet vehicles
- Fleet – 50 or more vehicles less than 12,000 lbs.
- DOR will calculate ad valorem tax
- DOR will issue registration
- Fleet license plate
- DOR rule making authority to expand to other vehicles (i.e. IRP)



MLI Task Force

- Eliminate 4 mo. suspension period
- Reduce lookback period for 2nd and subsequent violations to current and previous 2 years
- Increase licensing official's commission on reinstatement fee from 10% to 15%
- Change distribution date to 20th of the mo.
- Increase annual amount retained by licensing official's office from \$10K to \$25K
- Address inconsistencies with stored/inoperable vehicles



Print on Demand

- 66 counties & all 4 cities currently on POD
- Beginning Jan. 2019, MVD is updating plate designs/redesigns with a single decal pocket
 - Continue to issue month sticker
- Printing on POD Material
 - Use Original Manufacturer Ink
 - Paper Setting = Label/Vinyl Label
 - Toner Darkness Setting = 4 - 6
 - Vendor defaults print job to paper tray with correct receipt



Print on Demand

- Include DOR assigned control number in decal field on registration receipt and registration record
- County system should produce audit report with:
 - Control numbers
 - Time period
 - Sortable (clerkID, date, etc.)
- Remember vintage vehicle registrations still receive vintage decals and plain paper registration receipts

Print on Demand

- MLI Reinstatement fees (32-7A-12)
- Licensing officials retain 10%
 - 50% to county general fund
 - **50% Special registration/titling technology fund**
- Peace officers annuity fund 15%
- Remainder to fund MLI program and state general fund

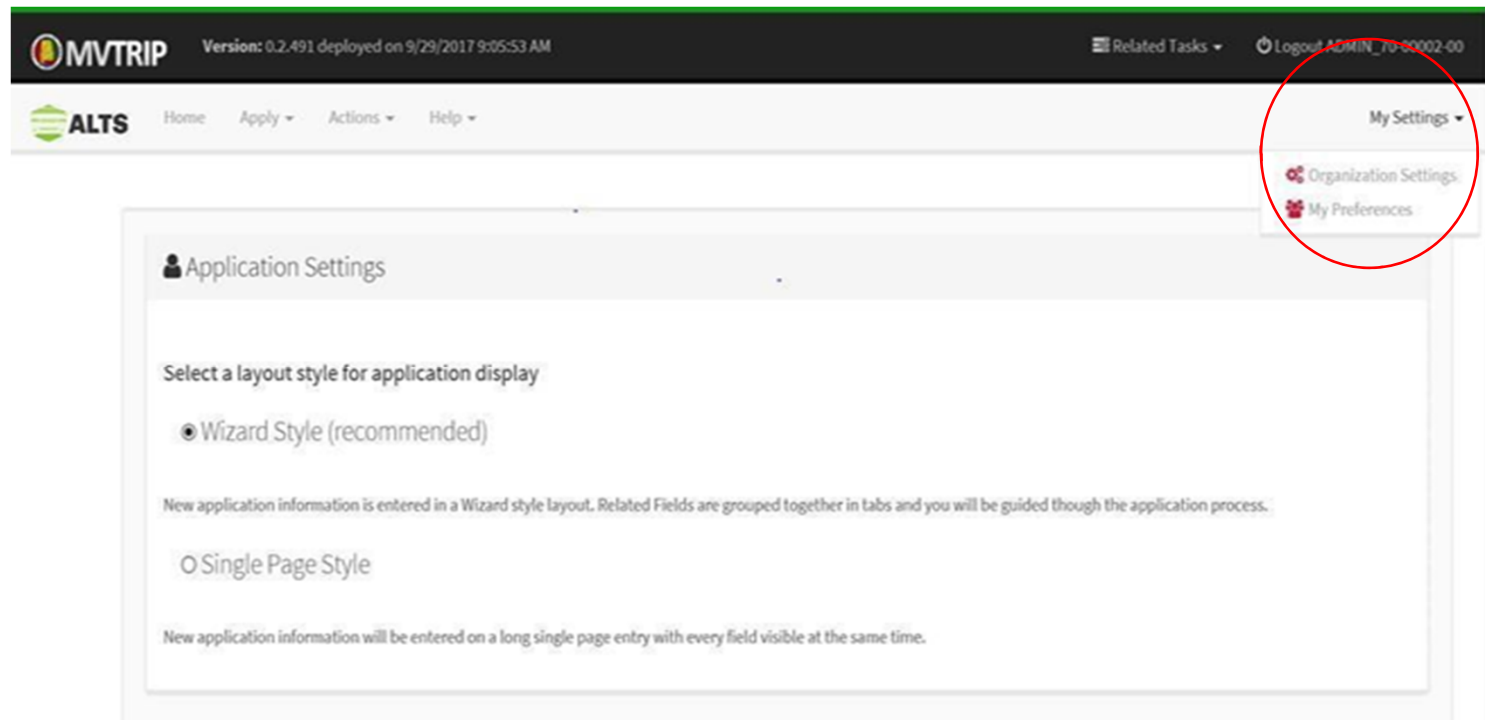

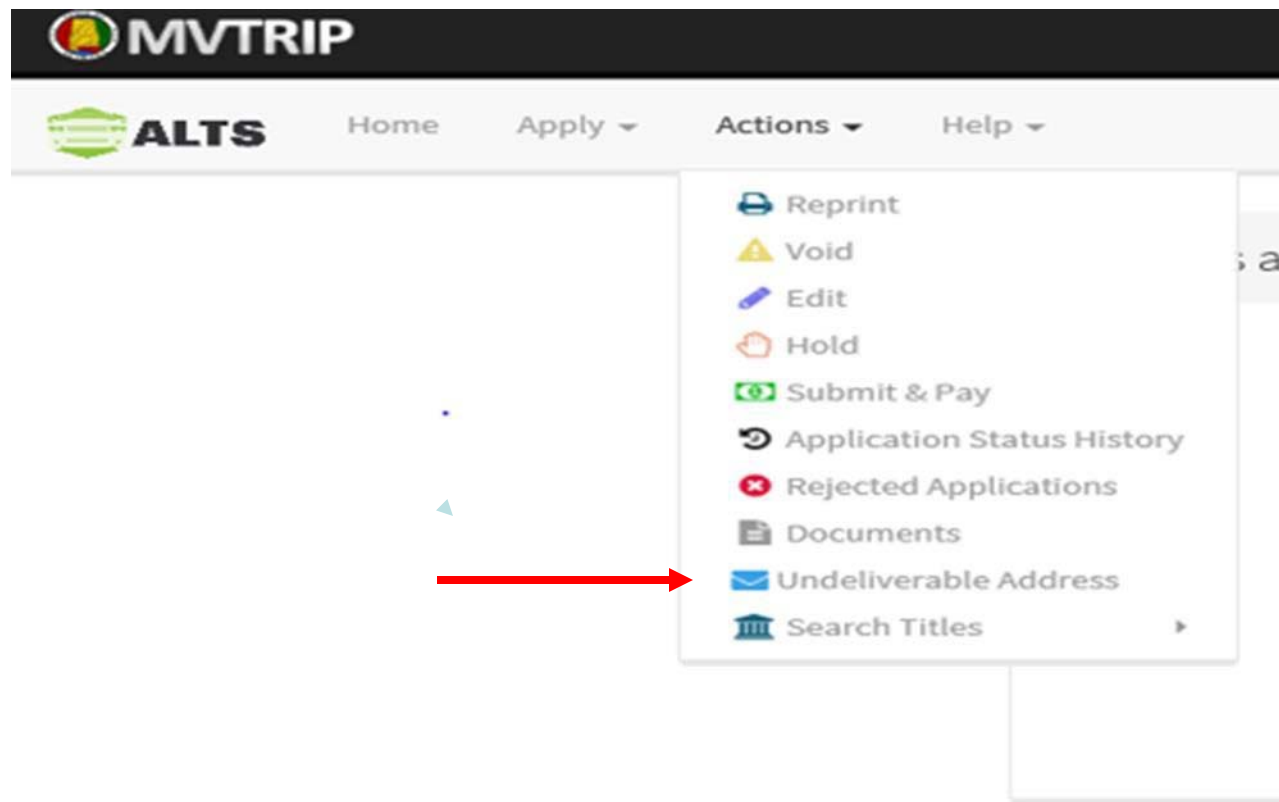

Title Surety Bond

- A Title Surety Bond is guarantee of performance of a specific obligation or contract.
- A bond is issued by an insurance company and guarantees damages in the event that another individual claims ownership of the vehicle.
- A bond is similar to your personal auto insurance in that it is offering coverage in the event that a claim is made, except in the case of a bond, the coverage is for the certificate of title.

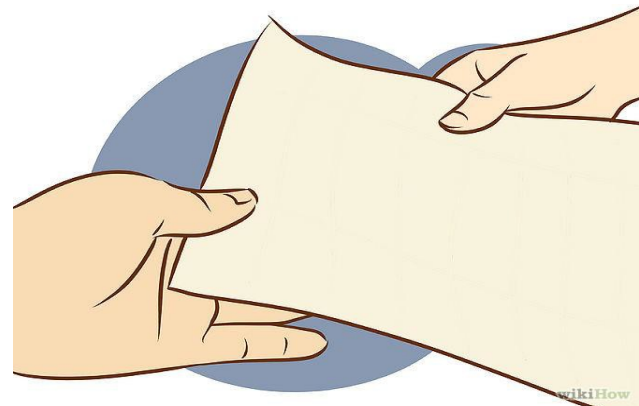




Title Surety Bond

Common Examples of when a bond is required:

- The vehicle was never titled.
- The owner never received a title.
- The previous owner did not title.
- An error occurred in the title assignment.





Title Surety Bond

- The Surety Bond can be obtained by any company that issues bonds and is licensed to issue a surety bond in the state of Alabama.
- Primarily, the cost of the bond depends on the amount of the bond coverage (face value).
- Other factors, including the applicant's credit score.

Title Surety Bond

- Standard bond amounts for type and age of vehicle.
- Document to substantiate ownership. (bill of sale, registration or outstanding title). Required with the application (MVT 10-1A).
- State of Alabama Bond Form, (MVT 10-1).
- Vehicles branded as Salvage, Parts only, or Junk are not eligible for title surety bond.
- Bond Term of three (3) years.



An Overview of the Bond Process

- Apply, on the surety bond portal, to receive a bond application, Form (MVT 10-1A).
- Submit the bond application and proof of ownership.
- When application is approved, a bond form (MVT 10-1) is sent to the applicant, via email.
- Take the bond form (signed/sealed by the insurance company) to a Designated Agent to apply for Certificate of Title with the bond as the primary supporting document.

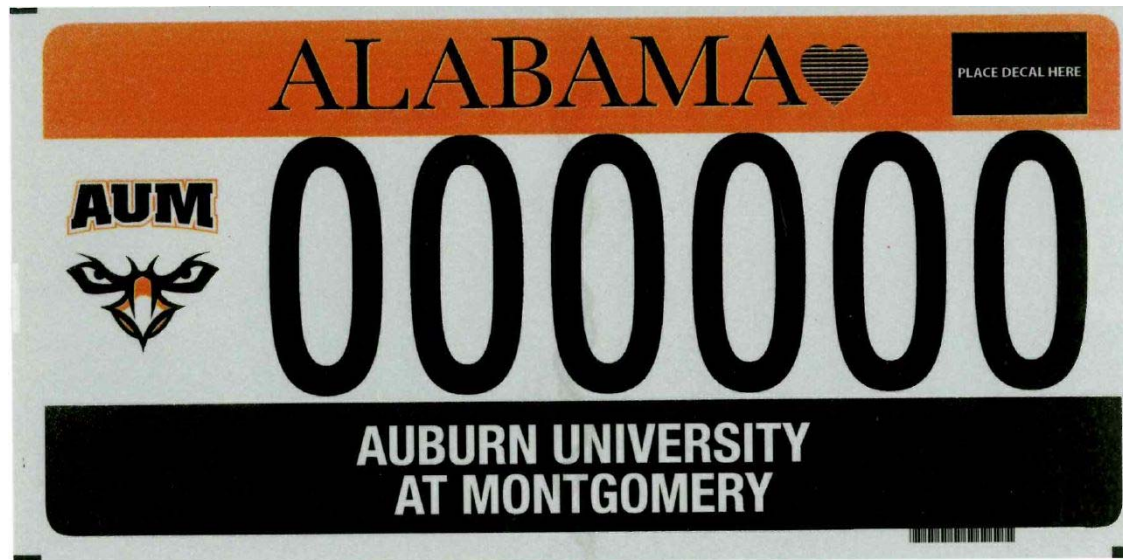

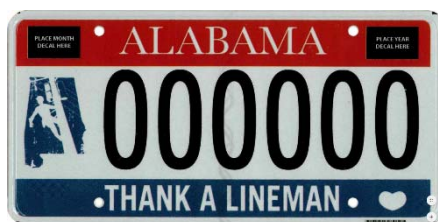

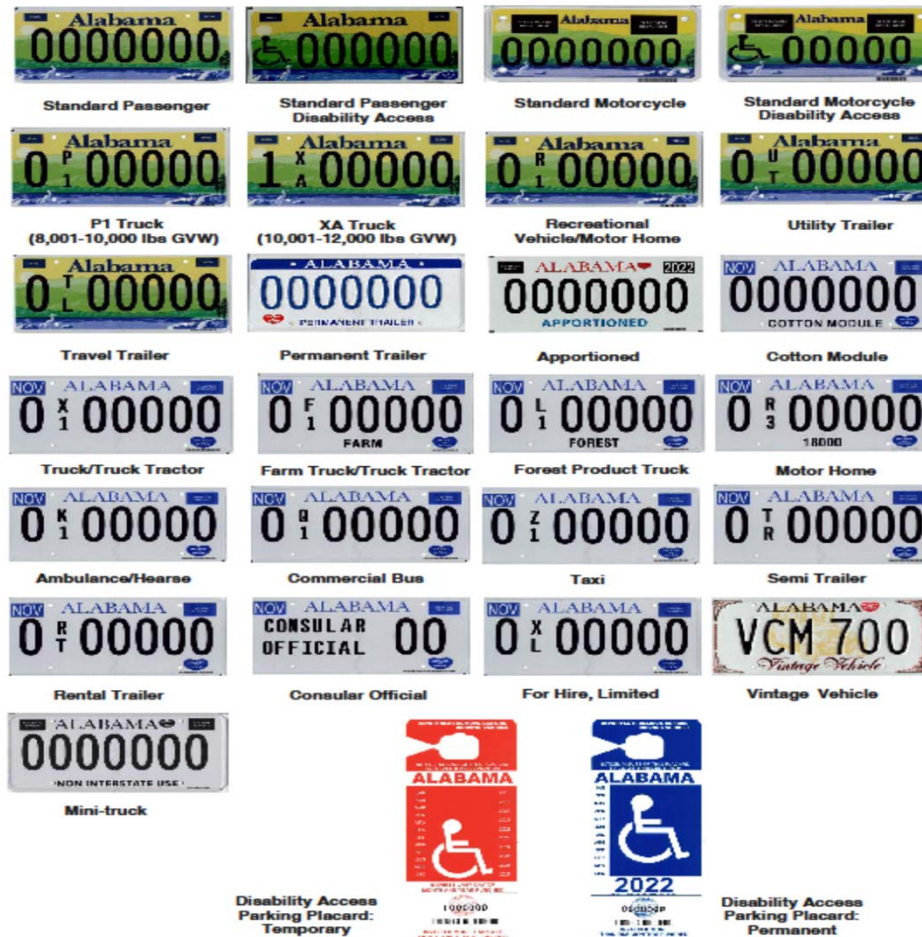

 - Required for trucks and truck tractors with a declared GVW (combined) 55,000 lb. or more
 - Vehicles registered in July, August, or September can provide FHVUT payment proof for preceding tax period (July 1, 2017 – June 30, 2018)
 - Proof not required for vehicles registered within 60 days of purchase
 - Memo 2015-29 – document to provide to these registrants detailing their requirements for filing
- Licensing Officials audited by ADOR
 - Failure to comply may result in the reduction of Federal highway funds
 - Federal Code Title 23, Part 669
 - 2018 audit completed



Federal Heavy Vehicle Use Tax (FHVUT)

Form 2290 (continued)

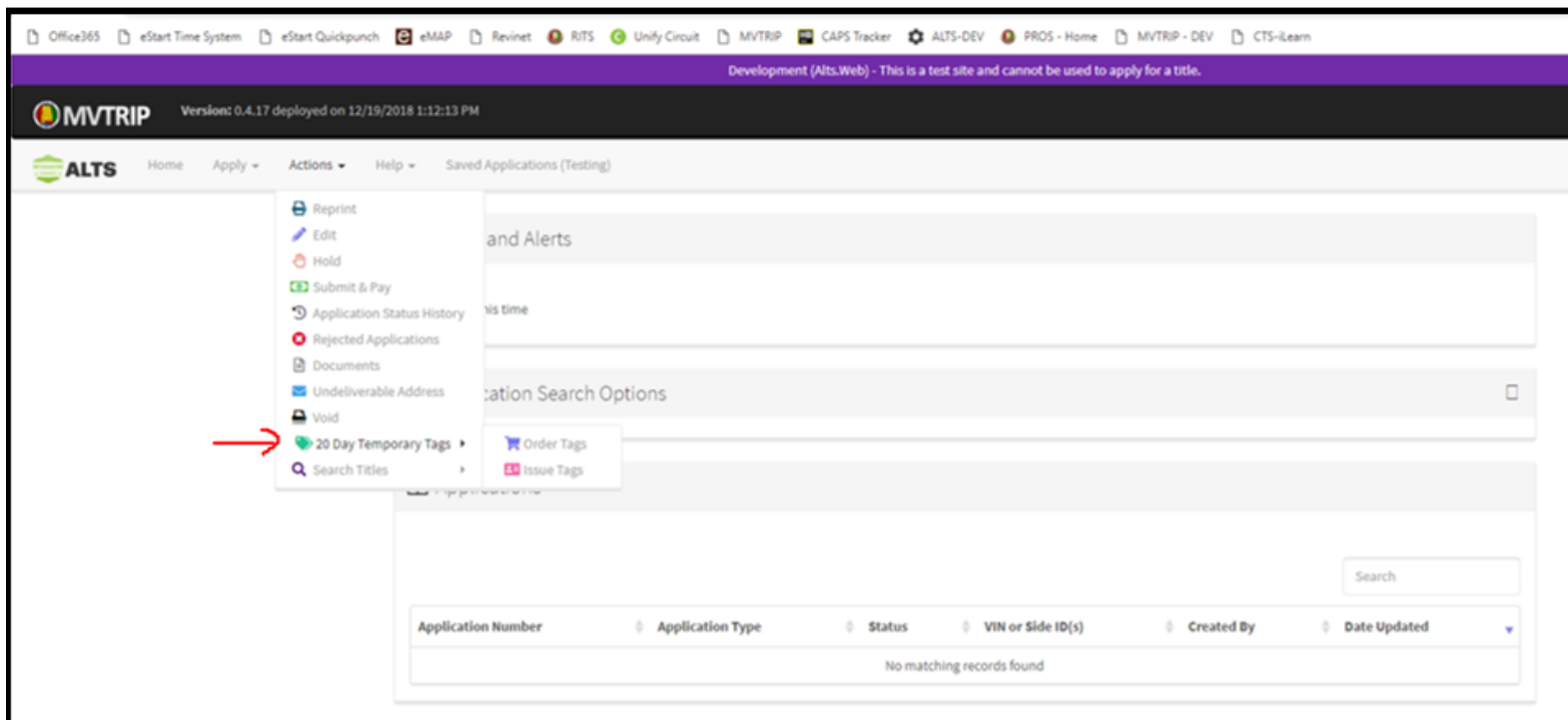



Records Request Portal

The Driver's Privacy Protection Act of 1994 (DPPA) (Title XXX of Public Law 103-322) as amended by Section 350 of Public Law 106-69 was enacted to protect the interest of individuals and their privacy by prohibiting the disclosure and use of personal information contained in motor vehicle registration and title record, except as authorized by such individuals or by law. Personal information is defined as "information that identifies a person, including an individual's social security number, name, address (but not the 5-digit zip code), telephone number, and medical or disability information."

The provisions of the Drivers Privacy Protection Act of 1994 (DPPA) apply to vehicles owned by a person(s); they **DO NOT APPLY** to vehicles owned by a corporation, proprietorship, partnership, limited liability partnership, association, estate, or trust.
