ORDINANCE NO. 022216

This ordinance amends Article VII, Section 10-8-2 of the Ordinances of the City of Luverne as follows:

SECTION 10-8-2 IMPOSE; AMOUNT – ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN POLICE JURISDICTION

There is hereby imposed, levied and assessed against every person engaged in the business of operating hotels, motels, tourist courts, tourist cabins, lodging houses and rooming houses renting to transients, or any other place in which rooms, lodgings or accommodations are regularly furnished to transients for a consideration, in addition to all license taxes heretofore imposed and now existing against them, an additional license tax equal to two percent (2%) of the gross income received by each such person from the renting of rooms or apartments outside the corporate limits but within the police jurisdiction of the City of Luverne.

This ordinance shall become effective April 1, 2016.

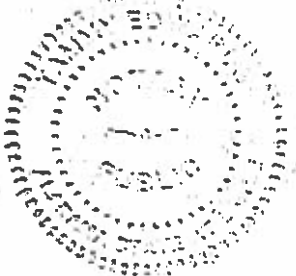

ORDINANCE NO. 01-02

This ordinance amends Article VII, Section 10-8-1 of the Ordinances of the City of Luverne as follows:

SECTION 10-8-1. IMPOSE; AMOUNT – ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN POLICE JURISDICTION.

There is hereby imposed, levied and assessed against every person engaged in the business of operating hotels, motels, tourist courts, tourist cabins, lodging houses and rooming houses renting to transients, or any other place in which rooms, lodgings or accommodations are regularly furnished to transients for a consideration, in addition to all license taxes heretofore imposed and now existing against them, an additional license tax equal to four percent (4%) of the gross income received by each such person from the renting of rooms or apartments within the police jurisdiction of the City of Luverne.
