- Chapter 7A, Title 32 Code of Alabama
  - Requirement for liability insurance policy on vehicle
    - To register
    - To maintain registration
    - Operate







- Chapter 7A, Title 32 Code of Alabama
  - Vehicles exempt from MLI law
    - Trailers (40-12-240)
    - Owned by government entity
    - Subject to Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration or Alabama Public Service Commission
    - Implements of husbandry
    - · Vehicle moved solely by animal power
    - Special mobile equipment (32-8-2(20))
    - Inoperable or stored vehicles not being operated
    - Covered by blanket liability policy or commercial policy
      - Administrative rule 810-5-8-.07
      - Owned by bank or finance company
      - Owned by motor vehicle dealer, reconditioner, or rebuilder and held in inventory







- Requirements of License Plate Issuing Officials (32-7A-17):
  - Registration suspended
    - Cannot process registration transaction
  - Reinstate registration upon request
  - Must verify insurance through OIVS or view evidence of insurance before registering vehicle
  - Valid DL, non-driver ID or FEIN required for one vehicle owner (registration renewal)







- Distribution of Reinstatement Fees Collected by Licensing Official (32-7A-12):
  - Official maintains 10% of fees collected
    - Distribution
      - » 50% to official's office
      - » 50% county/city general fund
  - Remainder to state







- Effective January 1, 2013, insurance verified utilizing an OIVS (Act 2011-688)
  - Law enforcement, license plate issuing officials and DOR
  - If "unconfirmed" response received
    - Must view evidence of insurance
  - Sample insurance documents
    - www.besuretoinsureal.com








- DOR uses OIVS to verify insurance
- DOR cannot confirm insurance policy on vehicle
  - Questionnaire
  - Notice of suspension


































YES Response – Valid Insurance on Verification Date


NOTICE TO VEHICLE OWNER: Any driver of an Alabama-registered vehicle convicted of operating the vehicle without liability insurance coverage as required by Alabama Iaw, or suspended vehicle registration, will be subject to fine of up to \$500.00 for a first offense and a fine of up to \$1,000.00 and/or his/her driver's license being suspended for a second or subsequent offense.

Furthermore, the owner of the vehicle will be subject to the payment of a reinstatement fee of \$200.00 for a first offense, and in the case of a second or subsequent offense, the vehicle owner will be subject to the payment of a \$400.00 reinstatement fee and a fourmonth suspension of their vehicle registration.


NO (Exempt) Response – Vehicle Stored/ Inoperable/ Sold



#### Monthly Reinstatement Report







- 810-5-8-.05 Evidence of Insurance Requirements
  - Present by electronic means
    - Electronic mail from registrant's insurer
    - Computer printout from insurer
    - Facsimile of proof of insurance
    - Electronic image/proof
  - Acceptable in name other than registered owner







- 810-5-8-.07 Vehicles Exempt from the MLI Law
  - Exempts vehicles from OIVS verification
    - Commercial/blanket
  - Evidence must be maintained in vehicle







- Rule 810-5-8-.09 ADOR Issued Identification Number
  - Valid DL, non-driver ID or FEIN required for vehicle owner
  - ADOR to assign identifying number to vehicle registrants
    - Licensing officials designated agents
    - Extreme cases only as determined by LPIO
    - Registrant must present other evidence of identity







- Rule 810-5-8-.09 ADOR Issued Identification Number (continued)
  - Other evidence document number
  - Reflect in registration databases
    - RD for driver's license state data field
    - Assigned number in driver's license number field
    - Leave driver's license expiration date blank







- 810-5-1-.237 Mandatory Liability Insurance (MLI) Registration Reinstatement Procedures
  - Vehicle with the suspended registration stored or inoperable
    - Registration revoked
    - New plate/registration required
    - Reinstatement fees not due


