TO: ALL PERSONS, FIRMS, AND CORPORATIONS making sales at retail and/or purchasing tangible personal property for use, storage or other consumption, engaged in the renting or furnishing of rooms, lodgings, or accommodations made to transients, in the City of Jasper, Alabama (located in Walker County).

Article 3, Chapter 51, Title 11, et seq., Code of Alabama, 1975 authorizes and empowers municipalities to levy a true sales, use, rental and lodgings tax identical to the corresponding State Tax Laws except for the rates of tax.

The governing body of the City of Jasper has adopted Resolution No. 2022-21 to commence services rendered by the Alabama Department of Revenue in the administration and collection of the sales/use taxes, lodging taxes, for the City of Jasper. This Resolution is effective July 01, 2022.

Therefore, your first City of Jasper local tax return filed with Alabama Department of Revenue is for the tax period ending July 31, 2022, which is due on or before August 22, 2022. These taxes are to be reported using the Local Tax return in My Alabama Taxes (MAT) at https://myalabamataxes.alabama.gov. A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO ADMINISTER AND COLLECT <u>(SALES, USE, RENTAL, LODGINGS)</u> TAXES LEVIED BY THE <u>CITY OF JASPER</u>

STATE OF ALABAMA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE JASPER CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JASPER, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Administration and Collection by Alabama Department of Revenue. Pursuant to the provisions of the <u>Code of Alabama</u> 1975, Section 11-51-207, the <u>City of Jasper</u> hereby directs that the Department of Revenue of the State of Alabama shall administer and collect all <u>sales, consumer use, sellers use, rental, and lodgings</u> taxes levied and assessed under the provisions of this Resolution to the fullest extent allowed by Alabama law.

SECTION 2. Certified Copy. The <u>City of Jasper</u> shall provide a certified copy of this Resolution to the Alabama Department of Revenue and shall also provide such other information and take such steps as may be required by said Department of Revenue to enable it to administer and collect taxes levied and assessed under the provision of this Resolution beginning on <u>July 1</u>, <u>2022</u>.

The <u>City of Jasper</u> adopted this Resolution at the regular meeting on <u>April 5, 2022</u>. This Resolution is effective as of <u>July 1, 2022</u>.
