RESOLUTION NO. 07.11.2022.2

WHEREAS, pursuant to Act # 2016-234, <u>Code of Alabama, 1975</u>, the Chambers County Commission was authorized to levy and collect an additional sales and use tax on automotive vehicle sales and use, agricultural equipment sales and use, manufacturing machine sales and use, and general sales and use and to distribute the proceeds of such additional tax levy proceeds; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Act # 2016-234, the Chambers County Commission was restricted in its imposition of general sales and use tax to a sales and use tax rate that is equal to the lowest municipal rate collected in the City of LaFayette, City of Lanett, or City of Valley on or after the enactment of said Act; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Lanett and the City of Valley have previously adopted and enacted Ordinances in their respective municipalities to levy and collect a general sales and use tax at the rate of five percent (5%) of gross sales or gross receipts; and,

WHEREAS, the City of LaFayette, by Ordinance No. 469 adopted by the LaFayette City Council on March 14, 2022 and by Ordinance No. 470 adopted by the City of LaFayette City Council on April 11, 2022, levied a general sales and use tax at the rate of five percent (5%) of gross sales or gross receipts with an effective date of June 1, 2022; and,

WHEREAS, based on the actions taken by the City of LaFayette, the lowest general sales and use tax levied in the City of LaFayette, City of Lanett, and City of Valley now equals five percent (5%) of gross sales or gross receipts.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Chambers County Commission that pursuant to Act # 2016-234, the Chambers County Commission does hereby levy and restate its collection of the following sales and use taxes:



- AGRICULTURAL MACHINERY SALES AND USE TAX. A sales and use tax of two percent.
- AUTOMOTIVE VEHICLE SALES AND USE TAX. A sales and use tax rate of two percent.
- 3.) GENERAL SALES AND USE TAX. A sales and use tax rate of five percent.
- MANUFACTURING MACHINE SALES AND USE TAX. A sales and use tax rate of two percent.

Said above referenced rates shall apply only in the areas in the county outside the corporate limits of Lanett, Valley, LaFayette, Waverly, and Five Points as those corporate limits were determined on April 14, 2006.

These rates shall also apply to the area of the county which constitutes the police jurisdiction for a municipality located outside the county provided the municipality has a sales and use tax in effect in the police jurisdiction in the county as of April 14, 2006.

The additional sales and use tax rates in the county outside the corporate limits of Lanett, Valley, LaFayette, Waverly, and Five Points as determined on April 14, 2006, but within the respective police jurisdiction of Lanett, Valley, LaFayette, Waverly, and Five Points shall be only one-half the corresponding municipal rates of the municipality having jurisdiction.

The gross receipts of any business and the gross proceeds of all sales, which are presently exempt under the state sales and use tax statutes, are exempt from the tax levied hereby.

The tax levied hereunder shall become effective on the 1st day of October, 2022.
