ORDINANCE NO 2022-12-12.1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO: 2022-09-26, WHICH LEVIES A PRIVILEGE, LICENSE OR EXCISE TAX AGAINST PERSONS, FIRMS, OR CORPORATIONS STORING, USING OR OTHERWISE CONSUMING OR ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF SELLING AT RETAIL TANGIBLE, PERSONAL PROPETY OR CONDUCTING PLACES OF AMUSEMENT IN THE TOWN OF CROSSVILLE, ALABAMA, AND ITS POLICE JURISDICTION; PROVIDES FOR PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND REPEALS A PRIOR ORDINANCE LEVING SIMILAR TAXES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL, AS THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF CROSSVILLE AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1: Subsection (c) (d) (e) is hereby amended to read 1% where it previously read 3/4%.
- Section 2: This section shall remain the same and unaffected by this amendment.
- Section 3: This section shall remain the same and unaffected by this amendment.
- Section 4: This section shall remain the same and unaffected by this amendment.
- Section 5: This section shall continue and be unaffected by this amendment.
- Section 6: This section shall continue and be unaffected by this amendment.
- Section 7: Severability. This section shall be unaffected by this amendment.
- Section 8: This tax levied and assessed by this ordinance is levied and assessed in lieu of rates Levied by Ordinance 2022-09-26, adopted by the Town of Crossville on the 26th day of September 2022.
- Section 9: Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective on the first day March, 2023 And the first payment of taxes hereunder shall be due and payable on the 20th day of April 2023.

All other parts, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect and are not otherwise effected by this amendment. This ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.
