The Town of Clay passed Ordinance 2022-03 on August 23, 2022, decreasing the sales and use tax food/grocery tax rate from 4% to 2%. In accordance with Act 2023-554, "An act of the Legislature or an ordinance or resolution adopted by a county or municipal governing body levying a county or municipal sales and use tax inclusive of food passed or enacted on or before the effective date of this act shall remain operative, but no additional county or municipal sales and use taxes on food may be levied."

The Town of Clay's sales and use tax rates effective September 1, 2023, are as shown below:

If sales of tangible personal property are made or delivered, or if purchases of tangible personal property are stored, used or consumed, outside the corporate limits of the city but within the police jurisdiction of the city, the rates of tax are one-half of those stated above.

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING ORDINANCE 2022-03

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama, adopted Ordinance 2022-03, on the 23rd day of August, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2022-03 amends Ordinance 2013-20 to remove 2% of the levied sales tax of 4% on certain food items as defined by the SNAP program for a period of 2 years, beginning November 1, 2022 and ending October 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it to be in the interest of the citizens' welfare to extend the 2% deduction of the levied sales tax of 4% on certain food items as defined by the SNAP program for a period of 11 months; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires for the said extension to coincide with the fiscal calendar year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama that the 'SALES TAX" of 4% will continue to be reduced by 2% on certain food items as defined by the SNAP program effective November 1, 2024 until September 30, 2025.
