TO: ALL PERSONS, FIRMS, AND CORPORATIONS making sales at retail and/or purchasing tangible personal property for use, storage or other consumption, engaged in the business of leasing or renting tangible personal property, engaged in the renting or furnishing of rooms, lodgings, or accommodations made to transients, in Calhoun County, Alabama.

Pursuant to Section 11-3-11.3, Code of Alabama 1975, the governing body of Calhoun County has adopted Resolution No. 12_14_2023 to commence services rendered by the Alabama Department of Revenue in the administration and collection of the sales/use taxes, lodging taxes, for Calhoun County. This Resolution is effective February 1, 2024.

Therefore, your first Calhoun County local tax return filed with Alabama Department of Revenue is for the tax period ending February 29, 2024, which is due on or before March 20, 2024. These taxes are to be reported using the Local Tax return in My Alabama Taxes (MAT) at <https://myalabamataxes.alabama.gov>. **RESOLUTION OF THE CALHOUN COUNTY COMMISSION
AUTHORIZING THE ALABAMA
DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO ADMINISTER AND
COLLECT SALES, USE, RENTAL, LODGINGS TAXES
LEVIED BY CALHOUN COUNTY, ALABAMA**

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Calhoun County, Alabama, by and through its governing body, the Calhoun County Commission as follows:

SECTION 1. Administration and Collection by Alabama Department of Revenue. Pursuant to the provisions of the Code of Alabama 1975, Section 11-51-207, Calhoun County, Alabama hereby directs the Department of Revenue of the State of Alabama to administer and collect all sales, consumers use, sellers use, and lodgings taxes for each locality code levied and assessed under the provisions of this Resolution to the fullest extent allowed by Alabama law.

SECTION 2. Certified Copy. Calhoun County of Alabama shall provide a certified copy of this Resolution to the Alabama Department of Revenue and shall also provide such other information and take such other steps as may be required by said Department of Revenue to enable it to administer and collect taxes levied and assessed under the provisions of this Resolution beginning on February 1, 2024.

Calhoun County of Alabama adopted this Resolution at the regular meeting on Thursday, December 14, 2023. This Resolution is effective as of December 14, 2023.


