TO: ALL PERSONS, FIRMS, AND CORPORATIONS making sales at retail and/or purchasing tangible personal property for use, storage or other consumption, in Henry County, Alabama.

Pursuant to Section 11-3-11.3, Code of Alabama 1975, the governing body of Henry County has adopted Resolution No. 10-19-23 to commence services rendered by the Alabama Department of Revenue in the administration and collection of the sales/use taxes, for Henry County. This Resolution is effective February 1, 2024.

Therefore, your first Henry County local tax return filed with Alabama Department of Revenue is for the tax period ending February 29, 2024, which is due on or before March 20, 2024. These taxes are to be reported using the Local Tax return in My Alabama Taxes (MAT) at <https://myalabamataxes.alabama.gov>. COLLECT SALES, USE, RENTAL AND LODGING TAXES
LEVIED BY THE HENRY COUNTY**


STATE OF ALABAMA

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF HENRY COUNTY AS
FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. Administration and Collection by Alabama Department of Revenue. Pursuant to the provisions of the Code of Alabama 1975, Section 11-51-207, the Henry County hereby directs that the Department of Revenue of the State of Alabama shall administer and collect all sales, use, rental, and lodgings taxes levied and assessed under the provisions of this Resolution to the fullest extent allowed by Alabama law.

SECTION 2. Certified Copy. The Henry County shall provide a certified copy of this Resolution to the Alabama Department of Revenue and shall also provide such other information and take such other steps as may be required by said Department of Revenue to enable it to administer and collect taxes levied and assessed under the provisions of this Resolution.

The Henry County adopted this Resolution at the regular meeting on October 19, 2023. This Resolution is effective as of February 1, 2024.
