TO: ALL PERSONS, FIRMS, AND CORPORATIONS; engaging in the renting or furnishing of rooms, lodgings, or accommodations made to transients in the City of Jacksonville, Alabama and its police jurisdiction (located in Calhoun County).

Article 3, Chapter 51, Title 11, et seq., <u>Code of Alabama 1975</u>, authorizes and empowers municipalities to levy a true sales, use, rental, and lodgings tax identical to corresponding State Tax Laws except for the rates of tax.

On February 26, 2024, the governing body of the **City of Jacksonville** adopted Ordinance No. 0-652-24 levying a new per room fee and increasing the general lodgings tax rate from 6.00% to 8.00% tax **effective June 1, 2024** with a due date of July 22, 2024.

Lodgings Tax Rates:	
General Rate	8.00%
Nightly per room fee	\$2.00

If you are conducting business outside the corporate limits of the City of Jacksonville but within the police jurisdiction, the rates are one half of the rates shown above.

The Law requires that the City of Jacksonville local taxes be collected, reported and remitted in the same manner as the State sales, use, rental and lodgings taxes. When you file and pay electronically, the City of Jacksonville local taxes are to be included on the electronic city/county tax return assigned to you (City and County Tax Return, form 9501). Simply enter the gross amounts and deductions, and all calculations will be done automatically for you. You may file these taxes through My Alabama Taxes (MAT) at https://myalabamataxes.alabama.gov.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 20-56 AND 20-57 OF CHAPTER 20 — TAXATION ARTICLE III. LODGINGS TAX OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, ALABAMA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE:

SECTION I SECTIONS 20-56 AND 20-57 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Jacksonville are hereby amended, to read as follows:

Sec. 20-56. - Levy of tax in the city.

For the privilege of engaging or continuing within the city in the business activities hereinafter referred to, there is hereby levied, in addition to all other taxes of every kind now imposed by law, and shall be collected as herein provided, a privilege or license tax against the person on account of the business activities and in the amounts to be determined by the application of rates against gross receipts, as follows:

- (1) There is hereby levied and imposed, in addition to all other taxes of every kind now imposed by law, a privilege or license tax upon every person engaging in the business of renting or furnishing any rooms, lodgings, or accommodations to transients in any hotel, motel, inn, tourist camp, tourist cabin, short term rental (STR), or any other place in which rooms, lodgings, or accommodations are regularly furnished to transients, for a consideration in an amount to be determined by the application of the rate of eight percent (8.0%) plus two dollars (\$2.00) per night per room of the charge for such rooms, lodgings, or accommodations, including the charge for use or rental of personal property and services furnished in such rooms, lodgings, or accommodations.
- (2) Of the eight percent tax imposed in subsection (1), eight percent is a general-purpose tax the revenues of which may be used for any lawful municipal purpose, and two dollars per night per room are dedicated for public safety to be split 75% Police Department and 25% Fire Department.
- (3) Provided, however, there is exempted from the tax levied under the provisions of this article any rentals or services taxed under the provisions of article ii of this chapter.

Sec. 20-57. - Levy of tax in the police jurisdiction.

For the privilege of engaging or continuing in the business activities hereinafter referred to within the police jurisdiction of the city but outside its corporate limits, there is hereby levied, in addition to all other taxes of every kind now imposed by law, and shall be collected as herein

provided, a privilege or license tax against the person on account of the business activities and in the amounts to be determined by the application of rates against gross receipts, as follows:

- (1) There is hereby levied and imposed, in addition to all other taxes of every kind now imposed by law, a privilege or license tax upon every person engaging in the business of renting or furnishing any rooms, lodgings, or accommodations to transients in any hotel, motel, inn tourist camp, tourist cabin, short term rental (STR) or any other place in which rooms, lodgings, or accommodations are regularly furnished to transients for a consideration in an amount to be determined by the application of the rate of four percent (4.0%) plus one dollar (\$1.00) per night per room of the charge for such rooms, lodgings, or accommodations, including the charge for use or rental of personal Property and services furnished in such rooms, lodgings, or accommodations.
- (2) Of the four percent tax imposed in subsection (1), four percent is a general-purpose tax the revenues of which may be used for any lawful municipal purpose, and one dollar per night per room is dedicated for public safety to be split 75% Police Department and 25% Fire Department.
- (3) Provided, however, there is exempted from the tax levied under the provisions of this article any rentals or services taxed under the provisions of article II of this chapter.

SECTION II. The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, then such ruling shall not affect any other paragraphs and sections, since the same would have been enacted by the municipal council without the incorporation of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

SECTION III. Effective upon adoption of this ordinance to the extent that all other ordinances or parts of ordinances of the City of Jacksonville conflicting herewith or inconsistent with the provisions in this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION IV - Effective date.

This Ordinance shall become effective June	e 1, 2024, following its	publication as required by law
