A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO ADMINISTER AND COLLECT SALES, USE, AND LODGING_TAXES LEVIED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMISSION

STATE OF ALABAMA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMISSION OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Administration and Collection by Alabama Department of Revenue. Pursuant to the provisions of the <u>Code of Alabama</u> 1975, Section 11-51-207, the Franklin County Commission of Franklin County, Alabama hereby directs that the Department of Revenue of the State of Alabama shall administer and collect all <u>sales</u> <u>use, and lodging</u> taxes levied and assessed under the provisions of this Resolution to the fullest extent allowed by Alabama law.

SECTION 2. Certified Copy. The Franklin County Commission of Franklin County, Alabama shall provide a certified copy of this Resolution to the Alabama Department of Revenue and shall also provide such other information and take such other steps as may be required by said Department of Revenue to enable it to administer and collect taxes levied and assessed under the provisions of this Resolution beginning on <u>July 1</u>, <u>2025.</u>
