## State Sales and Use Tax Rate Reduced on Food Beginning September 1, 2025

In accordance with Act 2025-305, the state sales and use tax rates on food will be reduced from 3 percent to 2 percent on September 1, 2025.

The city and county sales and use tax rates on food may be accessed at <u>https://www.revenue.alabama.gov/sales-use/tax-rates/</u>.

Food has the same meaning as defined in 7 U.S.C. § 2011, for the purposes of the federal Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP). SNAP eligible food items generally include any food or food product for home consumption, except alcoholic beverages, tobacco, hot foods, or hot food products ready for immediate consumption.
