
How to Apply for a Sales Tax Certificate of Exemption for Statutorily Exempt Entities through My Alabama Taxes (Form ST: EX-A1-SE)

Before you begin:


- An Alabama Sales Tax Certificate of Exemption shall be used by people or entities
 who are not required to have a Sales Tax License under the provisions of the
 Alabama Sales Tax Act.
- During the application process, you will be required to upload:
 - o FEIN Letter (Form SS-4) furnished by the IRS (for business applicants)
 - Articles or Bylaws (for business applicants)
 - Social Security Card (for individual applicants)
 - Blind Vendor will also be required to upload an official letter from the Alabama Department of Rehabilitation Services
 - Private School/Private University will also be required to upload a copy of their current year school curriculum which is summarized by subject and grade
 - United Way Organization will also be required to upload a current year list of all partner agencies
 - United Way Partner Agency will also be required to upload an official letter from the United Way stating their current beneficiary status
 - United Appeal Fund will also be required to upload a current year list of all supported beneficiaries
 - United Appeal Fund Beneficiary will also be required to upload an official letter from the United Appeal Fund stating their current beneficiary status
 - Federal Credit Union will also be required to upload an official letter stating the federal charter
 - State Credit Union will also be required to upload an official letter stating the state charter
 - School PTA/PTO/Booster Club will also be required to upload an official letter from the school administrator stating that all funds raised will exclusively be used for the benefit of the school



- 1. Go to https://myalabamataxes.alabama.gov.
- 2. Click the "Register a business/Obtain a new tax account number" under the Businesses panel.



3. Enter applicable information under "Enter your ID" section.





4. Select "Sales Tax Exemption" as the tax type you are applying for.

- 5. Complete the Taxpayer, Contact, and all other information as required.
- Answer the Preliminary Questions accurately to access the exemption application for statutorily exempt entities.



7. Select your Exemption Type from the drop-down menu.

An Alabama Sales Tax Certificate of Exemption shall be used by businesses or individuals coming under the provisions of the Alabama Sales Tax Act who are not required to have a Sales Tax License. Entities that fall into one of the categories below must apply with the Alabama Department of Revenue and provide supporting documentation specified in the application.

All entities, except for "governmental entities", that are statutorily exempt from Sales, Use or Lodgings tax are mandated to file the quadrennial or annual report of purchases as required by law. Governmental entities include the Federal Government, State of Alabama, Alabama public schools and universities, Alabama counties and municipalities, Healthcare Authorities, and public corporations incorporated under any of the following: Chapter 50 or 50A of Title 11, Chapter 5 of Title 37, or Chapter 7 of Title 39.





8. Attach or upload the required documentation for your exemption application.




9. Review the information in the summary for accuracy and click "Submit."
