
## How to Apply for a Utility/Mobile Communication Services Tax Certificate of Exemption through My Alabama Taxes (Form ST: EX-A3)


## Before you begin:

- An Alabama Utility/Mobile Communication Services Tax Certificate of Exemption shall be used by people or entities who are not required to have a utility tax and/or mobile communication services tax license under the provisions of the Utility Gross Receipts Tax and Mobile Communication Services Tax statutes.
- During the application process, you will be required to upload:
  - o FEIN Letter (Form SS-4) furnished by the IRS (for business applicants)
  - Articles or Bylaws (for business applicants)
  - Social Security Card (for individual applicants)
- 1. Go to https://myalabamataxes.alabama.gov.
- 2. Click the "Register a business/Obtain a new tax account number" under the Businesses panel.






3. Enter applicable information under "Enter your ID" section.



4. Select "Sales Tax Exemption" as the tax type you are applying for.




- 5. Complete the Taxpayer, Contact, and all other information as required.
- 6. Answer the Preliminary Questions accurately to access the exemption application.






7. Answer the out-of-state question, select your exemption type from the drop-down menu, and select the utility service you are tax-exempt from.



8. If not a Statutorily Exempt Entity, then select the county of your primary business location in Alabama. If you are a Statutorily Exempt Entity, then choosing a county is not applicable to your application.






9. Attach or upload the required documentation for your exemption application.




10. Review the information in the summary for accuracy and click "Submit."
