RESOLUTION OF THE TUSCALOOSA COUNTY COMMISSION AUTHORIZING THE EQUALIZATION OF SALES AND USE TAXES

WHEREAS, Act 1994-535 authorized the Tuscaloosa County Special Tax Board, at the direction of the Tuscaloosa County Commission, to levy and impose an additional sales and use tax to equalize the rate of sales and use taxes levied in the County to the highest rate of sales and use tax then being levied by the City of Tuscaloosa or the City of Northport; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tuscaloosa and the City of Northport have both raised the rate of sales and use tax collected in their jurisdictions and the Tuscaloosa County Commission has not yet directed the Tuscaloosa County Special Tax Board to raise the sales and use tax rate in the county; and

WHEREAS, the Tuscaloosa County Commission anticipates the need for additional revenue to continue to provide for the infrastructure needs of county residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tuscaloosa County Commission, as follows:

The Tuscaloosa County Special Tax Board is directed to levy and impose an additional sales and use tax to equalize the rate of sales and use taxes levied in the County to the highest rate of sales and use tax currently being levied by the City of Tuscaloosa or the City of Northport, with the proceeds to be used on infrastructure and capital improvement projects.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Tuscaloosa County Commission has caused this Resolution to be executed in its name and on its behalf by its Chairman on this the 27th day of August, 2025.
