WHEREAS, Act 2017-274 was passed by the Alabama Legislature and became law without the signature of the Governor in May of 2017; and

WHEREAS, Act 2017-274 authorized the Sumter County Commission to place on the ballot for a countywide election the question of whether the Act should become operative in Sumter County; and

WHEREAS, the countywide election was held in Sumter County on August 15, 2017 and the certified election results on the question of whether Act 2017-274 should be applicable in Sumter County were as follows: Yes, 1,785; No, 817, and

WHEREAS, Act 2017-274 is now applicable in Sumter County and the provisions of the act authorize the county commission "to levy and impose" a "privilege or license tax" for the purposes established by the provisions of said Act, and

WHEREAS, the Sumter County Commission wishes to levy and impose the tax authorized by Act 2017-274 and to collect, receive and distribute the proceeds of the tax in compliance with the provisions of Act 2017-274, which are incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the Sumter County Commission wishes to make the tax applicable and collected beginning on December 1, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the rate of the tax levied by the Sumter County Commission shall be that rate established in Sections 3 and 4 of Act 2017-274, the provisions of which are incorporated herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Sumter County Commission that the tax authorized by Act 2017-274 be levied effective at 12:01 a.m. on December 1, 2025 and such tax shall remain in effect until it is repealed by vote of the Sumter County Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all previous resolutions adopted by the Sumter County Commission regarding the implementation of the tax authorized by Act 2017-274 are hereby repealed and superseded by this resolution.
