ORDINANCE NO. 90-5

**AN ORDINANCE TO PRESCRIBE AND FIX LICENSES ON INSURANCE COMPANIES IN THE TOWN OF SYLVANIA, ALABAMA.**

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SYLVANIA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. FIRE AND MARINE INSURANCE - each person, firm or corporation doing a fire or marine insurance business in the Town shall pay four dollars (\$4.00) on each one hundred dollars, and major fraction thereof, of the gross premiums, less premiums returned, on policies issued for the preceding calendar year on property located in the Town.

Provided that each person, firm, or corporation which has not done business during the preceding year in the Town shall pay a license of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and there shall be an adjustment at the expiration of the year according to the schedule herein above specified.

SECTION 2. OTHER INSURANCE - each person, firm, or corporation doing insurance business, other than fire and marine, shall pay Ten Dollars (\$10.00) plus One Dollar (\$1.00) for each one hundred dollars or major fraction thereof of gross premiums, less premiums returned, on policies issued in the preceding year on lives of citizens of the Town.

SECTION 3. REPORTING - On the first day of January of each year, or within sixty (60) days thereafter, each insurance company mentioned in (1) or (2) above which did any business in the Town during the preceding year shall furnish to the Mayor a statement in writing, verified by the affidavit of the president, vice-president, or secretary of the company, showing the full and true amount of the applicable and the amount of the license tax due, said statement shall be accompanied by a check or draft for the amount of the tax due.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that should any section, paragraph, sentence or word of this ordinance hereby adopted

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be declared for any reason to be invalid, it is the intent of the Mayor and Town Council that it would have passed all other portions of this ordinance hereby adopted independent of the elimination therefrom of any such portion that may be declared invalid.

SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

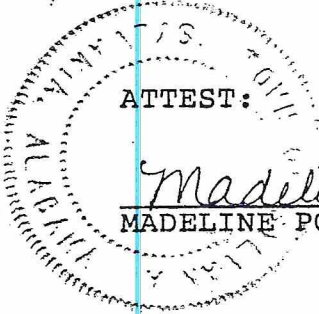
