# State of Alabama Department of Revenue



TO: ALL PERSONS, FIRMS, AND CORPORATIONS making sales at retail and/or purchasing tangible personal property for use, storage or other consumption, engaged in the business of leasing or renting tangible personal property, engaged in the renting or furnishing of rooms, lodgings, or accommodations made to transients, in the Town of Cordova, Alabama and its police jurisdiction (located in Walker County).

Article 3, Chapter 51, Title 11, et seq., Code of Alabama, 1975 authorizes and empowers municipalities to levy a true sales, use, rental and lodgings tax identical to the corresponding State Tax Laws except for the rates of tax.

The governing body of the Town of Cordova has adopted Resolution No. 2026-06 to commence services rendered by the Alabama Department of Revenue in the administration and collection of the sales/use taxes, rental taxes, lodging taxes, for the Town of Cordova. This Resolution is effective July 01, 2026.

Therefore, your first Town of Cordova local tax return filed with Alabama Department of Revenue is for the tax period ending July 31, 2026, which is due on or before August 20, 2026. These taxes are to be reported using the Local Tax return in My Alabama Taxes (MAT) at <https://myalabamataxes.alabama.gov>. ADMINISTER AND COLLECT SALES, USE, RENTAL, AND LODGINGS TAX  
LEVIED BY THE CITY OF CORDOVA**


STATE OF ALABAMA

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CORDOVA OF THE STATE OF ALABAMA, AS  
FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. Administration and Collection by State Department of Revenue. Pursuant to the provisions of Code of Alabama 1975, Section 11-51-207, the City Council of the City of Cordova hereby directs that the Department of Revenue of the State of Alabama shall administer and collect sales, use, rental and lodgings tax levied and assessed under the provisions of the Resolution to the fullest extent allowed by Alabama law.

SECTION 2. The City of Cordova shall provide a certified copy of this Resolution to the Alabama Department of Revenue and shall also provide such other information and take such other steps as may be required by said Department of Revenue to enable it to administer and collect taxes levied and assessed under the provisions of this Resolution.

The City Council of the City of Cordova adopted this Resolution at the special called meeting on the 19<sup>th</sup> of March 2026. This Resolution is effective as of the 1<sup>st</sup> of July 2026.
